To Supporters of Old Scotland Presbyterian Church:

Our committee recently obtained the services of an engineer to examine the building of the Old Scotland Presbyterian Church to make an assessment of its structural integrity. He discovered some major problems with the foundation and walls that, if not corrected, will result in serious and irremediable damage to the church building.

The engineer estimates that the cost to repair the structural problems that have already occurred and to prevent further damage would be over \$50,000.00. However, he estimates that just the cost of preventing further damage, without repairing the damage that has already occurred, would amount to approximately \$10,000.00.

The Old Scotland Presbyterian Church Committee believes that we need to raise at least the \$10,000.00 to prevent further damage with the hope that we can eventually raise the funds required to repair the damage that has already occurred.

We respectfully request that you give generously to the immediate need of preventing further structural damage to the Old Scotland Presbyterian Church building. If funds beyond the amount required to prevent further damage are raised, they will go toward the goal of repairing the damage that has already occurred.

We who are the descendants and friends of the Old Scotland Presbyterian Church bear the responsibility to see that this historic old church building, built in 1835, is maintained for future generations to worship and fellowship in it.
